BELGRADE – Serbia’s parliamentarians, members of the Global Organization of Parliamentarians Against Corruption (GOPAC), adopted on Monday a plan of activities until 2015, which envisages working with citizens and raising awareness of the necessity of the fight against corruption.



GLOBAL ORGANISATION OF PARLIAMENTARIANS AGAINST CORRUPTION

Chairman of the GOPAC Executive Committee Zoran Babic has told reporters that GOPAC’s next step will be to adopt the organizing scheme and structure of GOPAC’s regional branch office in Serbia, and to strengthen the oversight function of each and every MP.

“The plan of activities stipulates working with citizens and raising their awareness concerning the necessity of the fight against corruption, in which the executive and legislative branches and all citizens of Serbia should get equally involved,” Babic said, underlining the importance of cooperation with GOPAC’s regional and national branch offices, and transfer of “tools” that they are using in the fight against corruption so that they could be implemented in the Serbian society.

Babic recalled that GOPAC was formed in Serbia at the beginning of June this year.

Almost all groups in the Serbian parliament took part in the regional branch office of GOPAC, and now 12 MPs are in that organization, Babic said.

The UNDP took over the entire financing of GOPAC, Babic says, adding that there is good cooperation with the Belgrade-based Faculty of Political Sciences, especially with Zoran Stojiljkovic, who is a professor at that faculty and member of the Anti-Corruption Agency's Committee.
