## Close Collaboration With Foreign Agencies Help To Settle Cases Faster - MACC

KUCHING, March 31 (Bernama) - The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) said close collaboration with anti-corruption agencies in other countries has helped to settle cases faster.

Mutual Assistance In Criminal Matters Act (MACMA) Branch chief, Asst Comm Azmin Mohamad was confident that Malaysia's participation in the South East Asia Parties Against Corruption (SEAPAC) would facilitate the investigation process.

"The MACC has benefited much from good ties when solving cases involving witnesses or suspects abroad. Some cases were settled in less than one week.

"MACMA will use five procedures in investigating cases abroad namely submit application to the Attorney General's Chamber, review, validate, send to the Foreign Ministry and return to the MACC for further action.

Azmin said this when briefing a 15 member delegation from the Indonesian

Anti-Corruption Group (LAKI) at the Sarawak MACC office, here today.

Also present were Sarawak MACC director, Deputy Comm Datuk Bahri Mohamad Zin, LAKI chairman Burhanudin Abdullah and chairman of Anti-Corruption Brigade Malaysia (Sarawak), Datuk Seri Dr Razali Bolhi.
