

44 ELECTED MEMBERS FROM CONSTITUENCIES, AND ONE NOMINATED FROM RABI COUNCIL – IN TOTAL 45 MPs

Speaker

IS NOT A MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT, NOMINATED BY PARTIES AND ELECTED VIA OPEN VOTES IN ACCORDANCE TO SECTION 6 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURES;

Meeting Schedules

PARLIAMENT MEETS 3 TIMES A YEAR, AND SPECIAL MEETING CAN BE SUMMONED FOR NATIONAL EMERGENCY PURPOSES;

Parties

Promote Transparency, Accountability and Good Governance amongst parliamentarians, national and community leaders and the general public at large;


